Treasurer's Report

April's results were disappointing. Pledge offerings were \$4,000 less than budget, which resulted in total receipts missing budget. Total expenses were \$4,600 less than budget. The net results were that the net receipts for the month were \$2,800 behind the budget.

Year-to-date results for the 4 months ended April 30,2009 on budget as the short fall in receipts were offset by tlower actual disbursements compared to budgeted disbursements. The following are the results for April and the Year-to-Date:

We thank all of our children's parents for bringing them to our Good Shepherd Atriums on Sunday's at 9:45 again this year. It has once again been a wonderful experience for all.

The summer is once again upon us and we pray that you continue to bring your children to All Saints for fellowship and worship. We have something new for the summer months again this year. A great program that is called the "ONE ROOM SUNDAY SCHOOL FOR SUMMER". This program is designed specifically for children's Christian education where four or more age groups are taught in one classroom. It includes material that children ages 3 through middle school can study and learn together. They will grow together through comprehensive Bible Study, applications of Bible lessons to everyday discipleship, and a variety of age appropriate activities.
